**The Age and Sex Structure of Pioduran Population:  
 Facts from the 2010 Census of Population and Housing**

The recorded total household population or non-institutional population of Pioduran in the 2010 Census of Population and Housing (CPH) is 45,021, an increase of 682 persons from the 44,339 households counted in the 2000 CPH.

Of the household population in 2010, 38.4 percent were under 15 years of age or 17,283. Children below 5 years old comprised 11.6 percent of the household population in the entire municipality. Children aged 5 to 9 years old accounted for 13.4 percent while those aged 10 to 14 shared 13.4 percent of the total household population. In 2000, there were 18,526 children under 15 years old or 41.8 percent of the total household population.

In terms of the distribution by age and sex, there were more males than females in age groups 0-54 years in 2010 with the males comprising 52.1 percent of these age groups. Conversely, there were more females than males in the older age groups 50 years old and over. The males in these age groups made up only 45.7 percent.

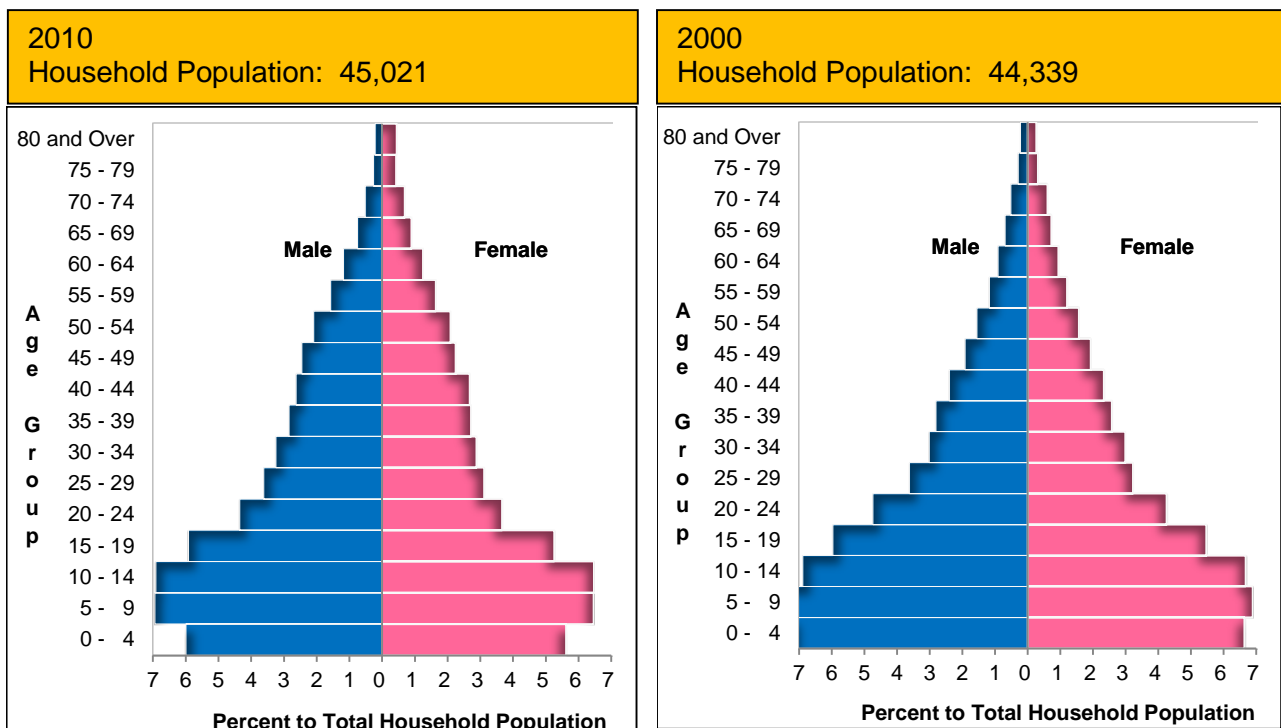


Figure 1. Age-Sex Pyramid of Household Population: Pioduran

### Median age stands at 20.3

In 2010, the median age of Pioduran population was 20.3, which means that half of the household population was vounder than 20.3 years. The municipality's median age for males in 2010 was 20.0, while that for females, 20.6 years.

### Sex ratio at 106 males for every 100 females

Of the 45,021 household population of Pioduran, 51.4 percent were males and 48.5 percent were females. This resulted in a sex ratio of 106.1 males per 100 females, which is higher than the sex ratio in 2000.

In 2010, children under 15 years old had a sex ratio of 107.0 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 15 to 64 years; the ratio was 108.6 males per 100 females. For the age group 65 years old and over the sex ratio was at 70.1 males per 100 females.

### Dependency ratio stands at 74

The overall dependency ratio of Pioduran was 74, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population (15-64 years old), there were about 67 young dependents (0-14 years old) and 7 old dependents (65 years old and over)].

### School Age Population

In 2010, the school-age population (5 to 24 years old) in Pioduran comprised 46.0 percent of the 45,021 household populations. Of the population who were of school age, the males made up 52.5 percent, while the females, 47.5 percent.

### Voting Age Population

The voting-age population (18 years old and over) accounted for 54.4 percent of the entire household population in the municipality. The voting population of Pioduran had 51.1 percent males, while the females comprised 48.9 percent.

### Senior Citizens population

Senior citizens are those aged 60 years old and over in the population. In Pioduran, they made up 6.6 percent of the 45,021 household population in 2010. Among the senior citizens, females (55.9 percent) outnumbered the males (44.1 percent).

### Ageing Index

Ageing index is the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years. In Pioduran, ageing index was at 17.2 percent in 2010, which translates to about 17 persons aged 60 years and over for every 100 children under 15 years old.
