**The Age and Sex Structure of Rapu-Rapu Population:
 Facts from the 2010 Census of Population and Housing**

The recorded total household population or non-institutional population of Rapu-Rapu in the 2010 Census of Population and Housing (CPH) is 35,737, an increase of 6,567 persons from the 29,170 households counted in the 2000 CPH.

Of the household population in 2010, 39.1 percent were under 15 years of age or 13,968. Children below 5 years old comprised 13.0 percent of the household population in the entire municipality. Children aged 5 to 9 years old accounted for 13.3 percent while those aged 10 to 14 shared 12.8 percent of the total household population. In 2000, there were 12,945 children under 15 years old or 44.4 percent of the total household population.

In terms of the distribution by age and sex, there were more males than females in age groups 0-54 years in 2010 with the males comprising 52.1 percent of these age groups. Conversely, there were more females than males in the older age groups 55 years old and over. The males in these age groups made up only 46.7 percent.

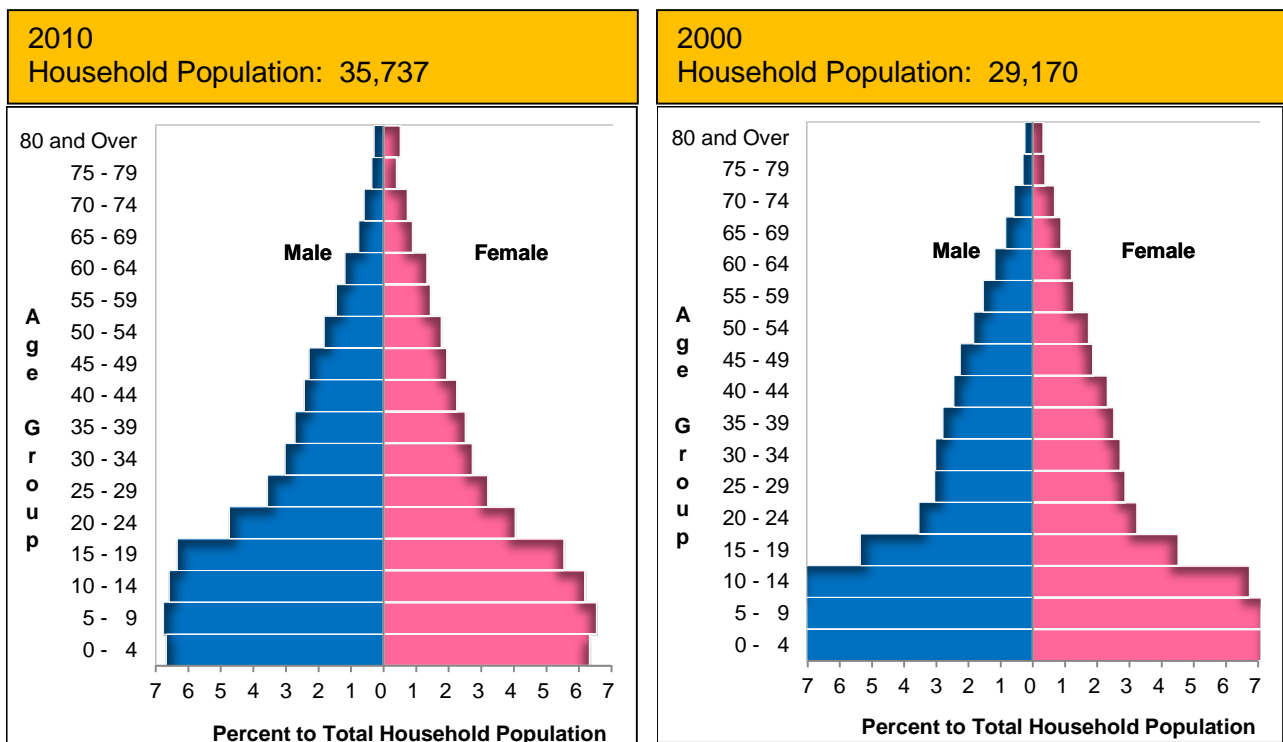


Figure 1. Age-Sex Pyramid of Household Population: Rapu-Rapu

Median age stands at 19.6

In 2010, the median age of Rapu-Rapu population was 19.6, which means that half of the household population was younger than 19.6 years. The municipality's median age for males in 2010 was 19.6, while that for females, 19.6 years.

Sex ratio at 106 males for every 100 females

Of the 35,737 household population of Rapu-Rapu, 51.6 percent were males and 48.4 percent were females. This resulted in a sex ratio of 106.5 males per 100 females, which is higher than the sex ratio in 2000.

In 2010, children under 15 years old had a sex ratio of 105.0 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 15 to 64 years; the ratio was 110.2 males per 100 females. For the age group 65 years old and over the sex ratio was at 78.4 males per 100 females.

Dependency ratio stands at 74

The overall dependency ratio of Rapu-Rapu was 77, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population (15-64 years old), there were about 69 young dependents (0-14 years old) and 8 old dependents (65 years old and over)].

School Age Population

In 2010, the school-age population (5 to 24 years old) in Rapu-Rapu comprised 46.7 percent of the 35,737 household populations. Of the population who were of school age, the males made up 52.2 percent, while the females, 47.8 percent.

Voting Age Population

The voting-age population (18 years old and over) accounted for 53.5 percent of the entire household population in the municipality. The voting population of Rapu-Rapu had 51.7 percent males, while the females comprised 48.3 percent.

Senior Citizens population

Senior citizens are those aged 60 years old and over in the population. In Rapu-Rapu, they made up 7.1 percent of the 35,737 household population in 2010. Among the senior citizens, females (55.0 percent) outnumbered the males (45.0 percent).

Ageing Index

Ageing index is the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years. In Rapu-Rapu, ageing index was at 18.1 percent in 2010, which translates to about 18 persons aged 60 years and over for every 100 children under 15 years old.
