The Age and Sex Structure of Ligao City Population: Facts from the 2010 Census of Population and Housing

Ligao City recorded a total of 104,738 household population or non-institutional population in the 2010 Census of Population and Housing (CPH), an increase of 14,202 persons from the 90,536 household counted in the 2000 CPH.

Of the household population in 2010, 37.3 percent were under 15 years of age or 39,105. Children below 5 years old comprised 12.1 percent of the household population in the entire city. Children aged 5 to 9 years old accounted for 12.7 percent while those aged 10 to 14 shared 12.5 percent of the total household population. In 2000, there were 36,808 children under 15 years old or 40.7 percent of the total household population.

In terms of the distribution by age and sex, there were more males than females in age groups 0-54 years in 2010 with the males comprising 51.7 percent of these age groups. Conversely, there were more females than males in the older age groups 55 years old and over. The males in these age groups made up only 44.9 percent.

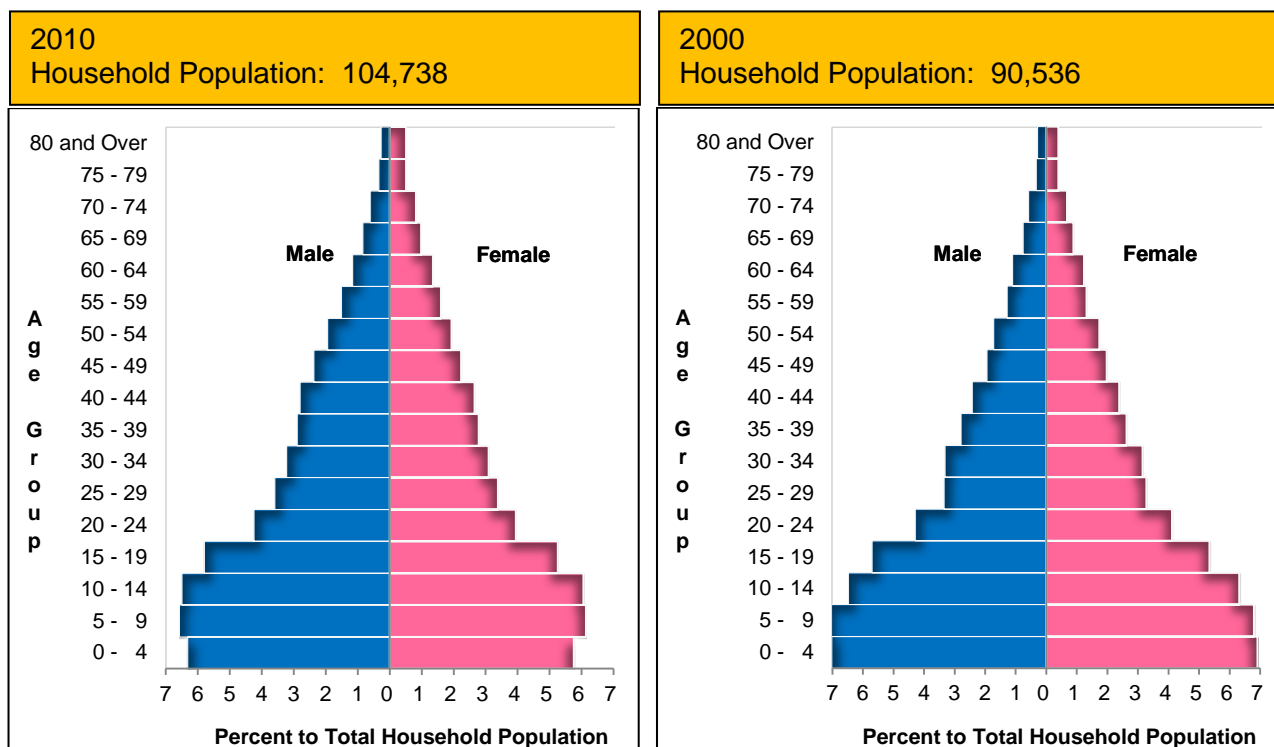


Figure 1. Age-Sex Pyramid of Household Population: Ligao City

Median age stands at 21.0

In 2010, the median age of Ligao City population was 21.0, which means that half of the household population was younger than 21.0 years. The city's median age for males in 2010 was 20.4, while that for females, 21.7 years.

Sex ratio at 104 males for every 100 females

Of the 104,738 household population of Ligao City, 51.0 percent were males and 49.0 percent were females. This resulted in a sex ratio of 104 males per 100 females, which is higher to the sex ratio in 2000 at 102.

In 2010, children under 15 years old had a sex ratio of 108 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 15 to 64 years, the ratio was 104 males per 100 females. For the age group 65 years old and over the sex ratio was at 72 males per 100 females.

Dependency ratio stands at 73

The overall dependency ratio of Ligao City was 73, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population (15-64 years old), there were about 65 dependents young dependents (0-14 years old) and 8 old dependents (65 years old and over)].

School Age Population

In 2010, the school-age population (5 to 24 years old) in Ligao City comprised 44.5 percent of the 104,738 household population. Of the population who were of school age, the males made up 51.9 percent, while the females, 48.1 percent.

Voting Age Population

The voting-age population (18 years old and over) accounted for 55.6 percent of the entire household population in the city. Of the voting-age population, 50.2 percent were males and 49.8 percent were females.

Senior Citizens population

Senior citizens are those aged 60 years old and over in the population. In Ligao City, they made up 7.4 percent of the 104,738 household population in 2010. Among the senior citizens, females (56.5 percent) outnumbered the males (43.5 percent).

Ageing Index

Ageing index is the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years. In Ligao City, ageing index was at 21.4 percent in 2010, which translates to about 21 persons aged 60 years and over for every 100 children under 15 years old.
